RUINED REMAINS—Firemen doused smoldering remains of an old feed mill this morning at 15 E. Fulton St., Edgerton, that was destroyed by fire of unknown origin Monday night. Edgerton Firemen were called to the scene at midnight and the building, grinding equipment and a large inventory of feed were destroyed in less than an hour, fanned by strong winds. Edgerton firemen using three pumper trucks, remained at the scene until 4:30 a.m. today. Frank Kuehn, manager of the mill, said no loss estimate has been made. The building, formerly owned by the Edgerton Farmers Warehouse, is now owned by Farmers Union Central Exchange (CENEX), St. Paul, Minn.
